



The MTN College Preparatory Program

The MTN College Preparatory program will focus on the academic journey of South Fulton & greater Atlanta area students. The Program will consist of **10-15 college prep cohort members**. Requirements for acceptance in this program include

- a verified rising senior in a GA high school, no more than 45 minutes away from the MTN head office (South Fulton, GA) for the selected academic calendar year
- A need for mentorship or assistance with the educational journey, either through school selection, financial aid, or mentorship.

Additional

- Extra Curricular & outside activities are required for mentorship pairing, if not provided the student will not be granted acceptance into the program
- GPA requirement will not matter for selection but is required for application

The College Preparatory Program is broken down into four phases that reflect the college application, selection, and matriculation process.

Phase One: Let's Prep *August 15th- September 30th*

In Phase One of The More than Numbers Program, Cohort Members will be set up with their MTN Team member. During Phase One, Cohort Members will meet the following criteria

- Understand the College Application Process
- Narrow down their schools from **Easy, challenging, and Reach**
- Prepare for College Applications

During Phase One, Cohort Members are expected to participate in the following

- College One-on-One Session (must be scheduled with MTN Team Member.)
- Cohort Night
- Attend Early Action vs Early Decision vs Regular Decision Seminar (public seminar)

Phase Two: Apply, Apply, Apply *October 1st-December 15th*

In Phase Two of the More than Numbers Program, Cohort Members will focus on applying to the schools determined during their One-on-One college session. During Phase Two, Cohort Members will meet the following criteria

- Understand the Next Steps After Applying for College
- Have applied to at least **ONE** college/university early action
- Have applied to at least **ONE** scholarship

During Phase Two, Cohort Members are expected to participate in the following

- Attend Fall Team Development Day
- Attend The Importance of Scholarships Seminar(public seminar)

Additional Requirements



- Complete MTN End of Semester Survey

Phase Three: Figuring it Out *January 10- March 31st*

In Phase Three of The More than Numbers Youth Program, Cohort Members will focus on narrowing a college decision, finding funding for college, and graduating from high school.

During Phase Three, Cohort Members will meet the following criteria

- Have at least **two** colleges/universities they are deciding to go to
- Have applied to The MTN Scholarship (Chort Scholarship)
- Have an understanding of

During Phase Three, Cohort Members are expected to participate in the following

- Complete Spring One-on-One College Session
- Attend Spring Team Development Day
- Attend How to Make a Decision Seminar
- Attend Life After High School Seminar

Additional Requirements

- Have a completed resume
- Be on track for graduation

Phase Four: Finish Strong *April 1st- June 15th*

In Phase Four of The More than Numbers Program, Cohort members will focus on deciding on a school, submitting their decision fee, and planning for steps after high school. During Phase

Four, Cohort Members will meet the following criteria

- Have Decided on the college/university they plan to attend
- Are walking at graduation
- Plan to attend the MTN Ceremony

During Phase Four, Cohort Members are expected to participate in the following

- Attend the MTN End of Year Ceremony
- Cohort's Pick Seminar (past cohort winners)
- Complete the MTN End of Program Survey
- Attend the Summer Team Development Day

The MTN College Preparatory Program is designed to help a student unlock its full potential by reflecting its college journey. With this students will learn skills such as resume building, essay writing, team collaboration, time management, and more.
